Can Your Child Attend French-Language Public Schools?

French language public elementary and secondary schools welcome all children who are eligible for French-language public education in conformity with Paragraph 23 of the *Canadian Charter of Rights* and the *Education Act of Ontario* and its regulations.

Our schools will admit students:

- who live in Ontario within the territory serviced by the *Conseil des écoles publiques de l'Est de l'Ontario* (CEPEO);
- whose father, mother or tutor pays taxes to the CEPEO and lives within the school board's territory.



One of the following linguistic criteria must be met by the father, mother or tutor:

- the first language learned and still understood is French; or
- has received his or her education at the elementary level in French in Canada; or
- has a child who has received or who is receiving his or her education at the elementary or secondary level in French in Canada.

Admission committee

A child that does not respect one of the linguistic criterias listed above can be admitted if his or her registration request is approved by a majority vote by School Board Trustees.
